Larry and Edwina were married on January 28, 1978. They have two children Maria Eliza born January 11, 1973 and Keturah Anne born October 3, 1981.



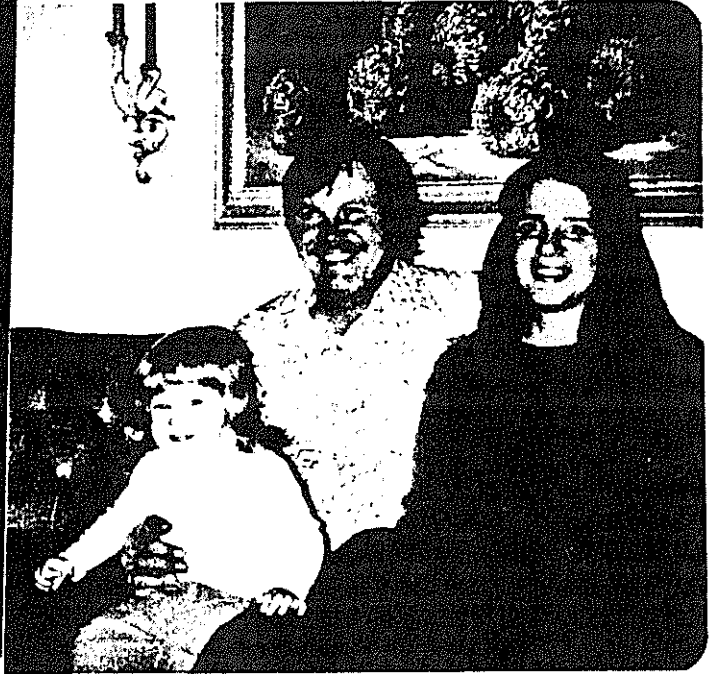
